### **Miss Ruby Butterfly Bush, Buddleia 'Miss Ruby'**

The spectacular thing about this buddleia is the vibrant colour. The large flower spikes are fuschia pink with hints of purple. These florets are larger, brighter and more abundant! The bush starts blooming in June and continues well into October. Miss Ruby has better branching and a more compact habit than other buddleia.

It can tolerate clay soil but will perform better in amended garden soil. Miss Ruby will attract butterflies, hummingbirds and it is deer resistant. \$22.00

### **Knock Out Roses**

There are many reasons why these are the most popular roses in North America. The [Knock Out @ family of roses](#) are easy to grow in any location with 6 or more hours of sun per day. The shrub roses look great when kept trimmed to 3 - 4 feet. The newer drift roses are a cross between a carpet rose and a miniature rose bush which makes them ideal for a smaller area of the garden. They are prolific re-bloomers starting during the early summer and continuing until the first hard frost. These **AARS (All-American Rose Selections)** award winners are also the most disease resistant rose on the market. 3 gallon containers are \$28.00.

### **Redpoint Maple, Acer rubrum 'Frank Jr'**

This must be a great new hybrid because the marketplace is already saturated with great Maple trees. This fast growing tree will tolerate a wide range of environmental conditions. The straight dominant central leader and good strong branching minimize the need for pruning. The dark green foliage is resistant to leaf chlorosis so there is less burning during the summer heat. Later the brilliant fall colour is considered to be more reliably red in Autumn. \$130.00 and higher.

### **Bartzella Peony, Paeonia 'Bartzella' Itoh Hybrid**

This rare and unusual beauty is a cross between a tree peony and a herbaceous peony. The best traits of each plant combine to form a superior hybrid. Bartzella has stronger, thicker stems which can hold the large flowers upright without staking. The lemon yellow double blooms are 7 to 9 inches across and a mature plant can have up to 80 blooms in one season with proper fertilization. Bartzella is considered to be the best of the Itoh peonies. \$40.00 and up.

### **Columnar Norway Spruce, *Picea Abies 'Cupressina'***

The tall slender pyramidal shape makes this evergreen an ideal choice for today's suburban homeowner. Dark green needles on vertical branches form a dense elegant specimen.

[Cupressina](#) has a fast growth rate maturing at 20 feet tall and 5-6 feet wide after 10 years.

**PowWow Wildberry Coneflower**

### **PowWow Wildberry Coneflower, *Echinacea purpurea 'PowWow Wildberry'***

This coneflower was the **AAS (All-American Selections)** award winner for 2010. PowWow was released in Canada in 2012. The winter hardiness of some of the previous fancy varieties of coneflowers was disappointing. But PowWow is grown from a seed and it is very

hardy. The bloom retains the magenta rose colour longer and will bloom continuously without deadheading. PowWow has a rapid growth rate and it will grow 18 - 24 inches tall. Once the root system is established it is also drought tolerant which makes it a great choice for the busy homeowner! \$5.00 and up.



**Whipcord Western Red Cedar**

### **Whipcord Western Red Cedar, *Thuja plicata 'Whipcord'***

A rare and unusual specimen which features long pendulous foliage that droops down like a hanging cord. This foliage is fine textured and turns copper-bronze in Autumn. This conifer prefers full sun or part shade and evenly moist soil. It is slow growing and forms a mound 2 feet by 3 feet wide in 10 years, so minimal pruning is

required.

### **Little Lime Hydrangea, *Hydrangea Paniculata 'Little Lime'***

This dwarf version of the popular limelight hydrangea easily fits into the suburban homeowner's landscape. It has a nice compact growth habit maturing at approximately 3 feet by 3 feet. The blooms open to a soft lime green colour and then turn vintage rose colour in autumn. This star from the proven winners collection can tolerate sun better than a lot of other hydrangea. ## ***And don't forget to nourish your plants!***

Slow release granular fertilizers are quick and easy to use. We recommend a 10-3-6 Shrub and Evergreen fertilizer. It is high in Nitrogen and also contains Iron and Sulphur. The 2kg box is only \$8.00 at Maidstone Tree Farm. Properly nourished shrubs will grow vigorously and are less subject to disease and winter injury.



Flowering plants require a fertilizer high in Phosphorus to promote vivid colour and lots of blooms. We recommend Green Earth 4-8-4 Rose Annual and Perennial fertilizer. Calcium, Magnesium and Sulphur are added to the natural organic base. This is another of our "loss leaders" at \$8.00 per box. Never use 10-10-10 fertilizer on any flowering plants. The plant will grow foliage but too much Nitrogen will discourage the production of blooms.
